ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE TO CREATE AND ENACT AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BUFFALO, NORTH DAKOTA, RELATING TO RESTRICTIONS OF ACCEPTABLE MATERIALS ALLOWED AT THE DEDICATED "TREE PILE".

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BUFFALO, NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. The following Ordinance of the City of Buffalo is hereby created and enacted to read as follows:

All material abandoned at the "Tree Pile" owned by the City of Buffalo must belong to a resident of, or property owner within the City of Buffalo where the material was physically produced. No person shall dispose of building materials, garbage, refuse or any other material other than trees, tree branches, grass clippings, leaves, or plant flesh. Absolutely no open burning is allowed, other than that conducted by The City of Buffalo. There shall be no discharging of firearms at the dedicated "Tree Pile". The terms of North Dakota Administrative Code, Chapter 33-15-04, are hereby incorporated into this ordinance. Violation of this section shall be an infraction, punishable by a fine of not more than \$500 (five-hundred dollars). Upon conviction of the first offense within a five-year period, the minimum fine to be imposed must be at least \$100 (one hundred dollars). Upon conviction of a second or third subsequent conviction within a five-year period, the minimum to be imposed must be at least \$200 (two hundred dollars).

SECTION 2. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect

from and after the date of its final passage and publication.
