Reviewed potential yearly tax income \$7,000-\$10,000 based on home developments from estimated valuation.

Discussed bonding options to fund, if moving forward.

Motion to price casual cost analysis of unit cost for roads as well as sewer and water for Option A layout (traditional block layout) and Option B (dog bone style cul-de-sac layout) by Steckler, seconded by Lawson

Motion to price casual cost analysis with a lift station to handle the development by Kasin, seconded by Steckler. MCU.
